Services Provided

Speech-Language Pathology - Provided by a licensed and certified pediatric speech-language pathologist. Speech and language therapy focuses on the development of functional communication which includes the use of intention, pragmatics, sound production, comprehension, and oral-motor development. It can also help address feeding and swallowing issues.

Occupational Therapy - Provided by a certified and licensed pediatric occupational therapist trained in sensory processing/integration, visual perceptual and fine motor skills. Families are trained in ways to enhance their child's attention/focus, and our OT's provide activities that incorporate development of all skills in daily activities.















Physical Therapy - Provided by a certified and licensed physical therapist specializing in pediatrics. Our PT's build strength and movement skills and train families in activities to foster gross motor skills such as rolling, crawling and walking.

Early Childhood Education - Our Early Childhood Educators hold at least a bachelor's level education. They facilitate a child's overall development, foster how they learn and grow and collaborate with specialized staff and family to create a comprehensive plan for the child.

Behavior Supports- Our Board Certified ABA specialists hold at least a Master's degree in education, psychology or a related field. They help families to identify patterns surrounding a child's behavior, make changes to the child's surroundings, and learn strategies to help increase positive behaviors and identify and teach skills that a child needs to help reduce problem behaviors.

All of our providers are committed to providing services to the family in the child's natural environment. Collaboration and consultation among all team members is highly emphasized in order to match each child and family's individualized needs.
